An exciting family attraction offering an immersive experience telling the story of embarkation from a busy wartime dockyard.

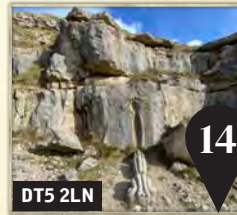

Tells the stories that have led to the creation of present day Weymouth. Located within Brewers Quay near the harbour.

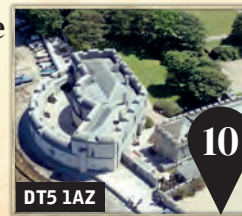

Climb the lighthouse and visit the former lighthouse keeper's dwellings now featuring fun and informative displays and activities.

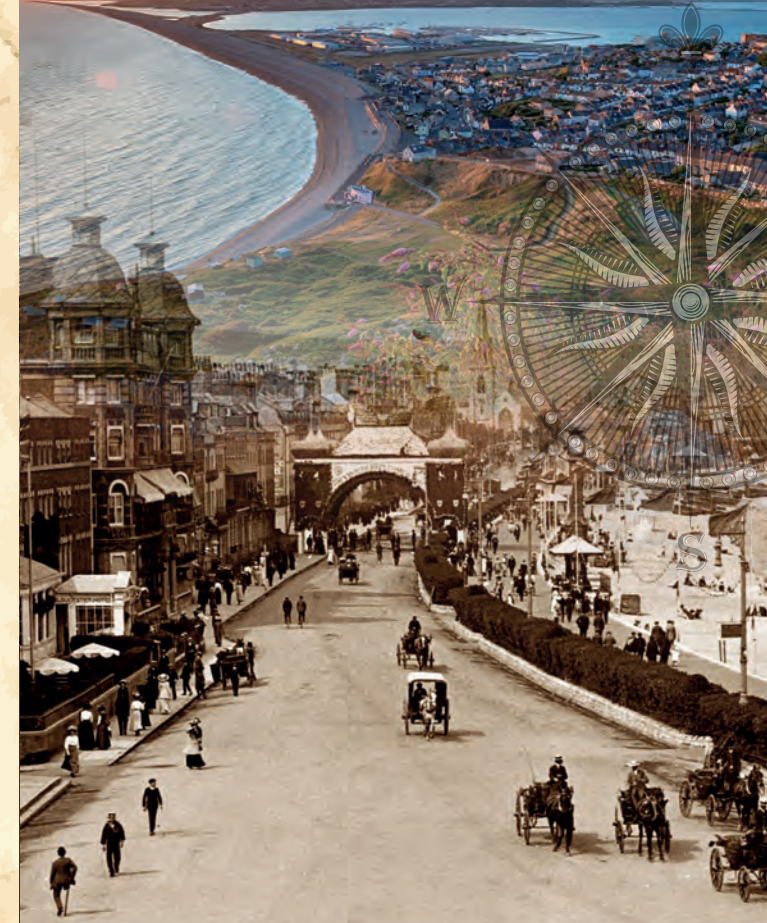
